Work Crew Duties

1. Edge and/or mow around the tractor shed, the cook shack, the lean-to, and the field entry gate where the mowing crew can't reach with the tractor.
2. Pick up any trash and find a volunteer to take it home and throw it away.
3. Do three hours of what needs to be done to keep our flying field in flying shape.
4. Place a check beside your name on the checklist provided in the light brown shed when you are finished.
5. Lock up all tools and equipment in the light brown shed when you are done.

General Guidelines

- Work crew member whose name is highlighted in yellow is the crew Chief

- Contact members of your work crew and schedule a workday that is convenient to all of you.
- If you can't find a common date, then pick separate dates and divide the work as appropriate.
- If you have a conflict and can't make it during the assigned week, you may make up your workday on any other week of the year (join one of the other work crews, or work when you can).
- Work at your own level as your health permits.
- Power tools are available in the light brown shed. You have already received the combinations for the gates and the shed when you paid your dues. If you do not know these combinations, contact the club vice president.
